Dear Mr Makwethu

I enclose Part One of an affirmed complaint regarding major ongoing breaches of the PFMA involving many millions of rands and other material irregularities including crimes committed in a corruption cover-up by past and current high officers of Legal Aid South Africa ('LASA').

There've been two significant developments since the complaint was signed and attested.

*First*, the newspapers reported that despite clean audits given South African Airways by its external auditor PWC year after year, your office found a complete shambles when it looked at its books. PWC is also LASA's external auditor, and after reading my complaint you'll find the same thing. In short, in a display of the grossest professional indolence, PWC has been charging the state millions to green-tick the most obvious financial and other corruption.

*Second*, Chief Justice Mogoeng Mogoeng has just taken an interest in some of the criminal and other corruption I've uncovered at LASA, reported to the Judicial Service Commission ('JSC') in eight complaints against then LASA Board chairperson Dunstan Mlambo JP, head of the North and South Gauteng

Divisions of the High Court. In response to a letter I wrote him at the end of last year, his office called me a week ago on the 18th – after hours at 8.33 pm – urgently requesting copies of my complaints.
