**Complaint: Advocate A. Brink**

We acknowledge receipt of your letter dated 25 July 2017 and confirm having separately received 9 (nine) volumes of attachments consisting of 8 (eight) complaints by Advocate Brink to the Judicial Service Commission.

The complaints consist of 264 (two hundred and sixty four) pages in number and having read through all of them, it was apparent that there are no new issues that Advocate Brink is raising. The substantial part of the complaints have already been ventilated and dealt with at the Durban Labour Court and the Labour Appeal Court. Other matters raised arise out of the applications he made at Eshowe Magistrates Court which now form part of two applications set down for 27 October 2017 at the Pietermaritzburg High Court.


Advocate Brink does not respond to our complaint submitted to your Society but rather demonstrates that he has also lodged complaints against Judge President Mlambo.

It is not our intention to respond to his complaints, however it is interesting to note that he further makes unsubstantiated inflammatory statements against Judge President Wagley.

We have furnished you with a record of the Labour Court proceedings highlighting the causes of complaint and we affirm our position and request that the matter be finalised swiftly.

We also attach for your convenience, the answering affidavit of Advocate Brink in the pending proceedings scheduled for 27 October 2017 to indicate his continued unrepentance towards the judiciary.
