12. The *'letter from the Legal Aid SA who had confirmed through a mandate from the new CEO that he wished to continue with the complaint'** of professional misconduct made against me. (*Per LPC Senior Legal Officer Nadira Harripersad's email to me of 30 May 2025.)
13. The LPC's *preceding* correspondence with LASA enquiring as to LASA's wishes about the LPC's disposal of the complaint in light of my comprehensive response to it in June 2021.
14. The LPC's *subsequent* correspondence with LASA informing it that, notwithstanding my said response, the LPC had decided nonetheless that I was *prima facie* guilty of professional misconduct for persistently complaining, in my several litigations against LASA and to the JSC, about Mlambo JP's repeated criminal and other impeachable misconduct as then-chairman of LASA (which complaints about Mlambo JP's criminal and other capital misconduct the JCC Appeal Committee found on 19 February 2024 to have indeed been well-made by me on the documentary and other evidence I'd adduced, and that they were answerable before a Judicial Conduct Tribunal).
15. The LPC's PAIA manual published under section 14 of PAIA, read with the criminal penalty provisions of section 90(2): *'An information officer who wilfully or in a grossly negligent manner fails to comply with the provisions of section 14 commits an offence and is liable on conviction to a fine, or to imprisonment for a period not exceeding two years.'*
