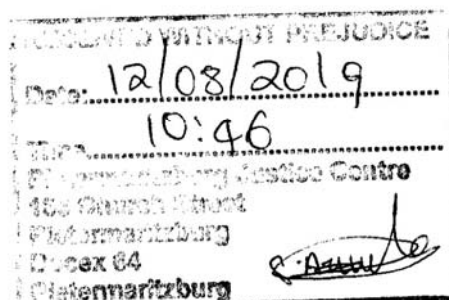
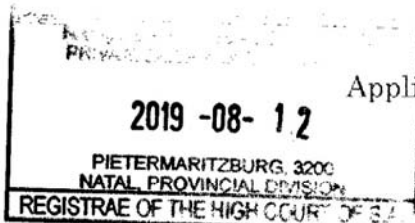

NOTICE TO REGISTRAR UNDER PRACTICE DIRECTION 9.4.4

KINDLY TAKE NOTICE that on 8 August 2019 the case-managing judge, the Honourable Mr Justice A Van Zyl, certified that this application is ready for argument on 30 August 2019, subject to the ordering of the papers – which has been attended to today.

TAKE NOTICE FURTHER that by reason of the substantial volume of the application papers, they will need to be taken up to the judge allocated to hear the application *immediately*, to provide sufficient time to prepare for the hearing.

TAKE NOTICE FURTHER that although, at the applicant's request, Van Zyl J directed that this application ('the first application') proceed alone, and not also the applicant's subsequently launched similar applications under case numbers 14224/17P and 5239/18P ('the second and third applications'), which, on 15 March 2019, were also postponed for hearing to 30 August 2019, the applicant's replying affidavit in the first application references documents put up with his second and third applications, to avoid proliferation of the already voluminous papers.
