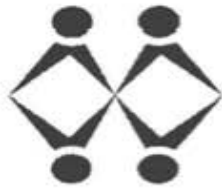

This request was addressed to the Information Officer of Department of Justice and Correctional Services on 27 November 2015 and referred to Information Officer of Legal Aid South Africa on 3 December 2015 in terms of section 20 of the Act. Five records were sought namely, approved budgets for 2010/11, 2011/12, 2012/13, 2013/14, and 2014/15 financial years.</p>
